Regular monthly meeting minutes  
May 12, 2009

The regular monthly meeting was called to order at 7:30PM with Board, Clerk and Treasurer present.

The minutes from the April meeting were read and approved with a motion by Hetze, second by Lobner. Carried.

The recycling center was discussed at length and nothing was resolved.

A motion was made by Lobner, second by Hetze to allow Dan Hansen to complete Novotny and Becker inspections and retain John Hoffman as the town's UBC inspector. Carried.

A motion was made by Lobner, second by Hetze to request bids for blacktop, road base, granite, mowing, dustproofing and crack sealing. Carried.

In roadwork discussions, a motion was made by Hetze, second by Lobner to dustproof 2 miles of Vruwink and Lonely Road. Carried.

A motion was made to by Hetze, second by Lobner to repair the culvert on S and Paradise Rd. Carried.

A motion was made by Lobner, second by Hetze to put granite on Vruwink Rd. Carried.

In public input, a request was made for the purchase of cigarette disposal systems at the entrances of the town hall. A motion was made by Hetze, second by Lobner to approve the purchase of these. Carried.

In correspondence, a motion was made to sign a document to oppose the labor threshold by Lobner, second by Hetze. Carried.

A motion was made by Lobner second by Hetze to adjourn.
