Resolution to Address Damage to Mailboxes
05-2013

Whereas s. 82.03, Wis. Stat. grants authority to the Town Board for the oversight of highways,

Whereas, s. 82.03 (a) states that the town board shall have the care and supervision of all highways under the town's jurisdiction, for the construction, repair and maintenance of the highways.

Whereas, the Town of Sherry provides for the maintenance of the highways within the town's jurisdiction by providing mowing road ditches, snow removal, grading, tree and brush removal, along with other tasks necessary to maintain said highways.

Whereas, such activities may cause damage to roadside mail boxes,

Now, therefore be it resolved, that the town board of the Town of Sherry, Wood County, Wisconsin, has determined that the Town is not liable for damage to mailboxes during the normal course of maintaining the roadways.
