1. The Town of Sherry is not meeting the DNR's goal for Recycling which is 82.40 lbs. per capita. The amount collected was 43.85 lbs. per capita. This is comparable to the 2018 collection rate. Wednesday night collection hours were added for the summer of 2019. The Town Board continues to consider implementing curbside (roadside) pick-up of garbage and recycling. The price would be between \$11 and \$15 per household per month for garbage and recycling service. A cost-benefit analysis has not been completed to compare to the current drop-off collection at the Sherry-Milladore Recycling Center. Town members discussed costs of recycling center. Board will continue to evaluate the costs of the recycling and solid waste services.
